I'm looking for the simplest way to convert a string containing valid XML into an XElement object in C#. How can you turn this into an XElement? <item><name>wrench</name><...I started to use Json.NET to convert a string in JSON format to object or viceversa. I am not sure in the Json.NET framework, is it possible to convert a string in JSON to XML format and viceversa?Note.
