Zora Neale Hurston (January 7, 1891 – January 28, 1960) was an influential author of African-American literature and an anthropologist, who portrayed racial struggles in the early-20th-century American South, and published research on Haitian Vodou. The most popular of her four novels is *Their Eyes Were Watching God*, published in 1937. Discussion. Maslow has been a very inspirational figure in personality theories.
