

# Download Wechsler Bellevue Intelligence Scale

The Wechsler Adult Intelligence Scale (WAIS) is an IQ test designed to measure intelligence and cognitive ability in adults and older adolescents. The original WAIS (Form I) was published in February 1955 by David Wechsler, as a revision of the Wechsler–Bellevue Intelligence Scale, released in 1939. It is currently in its fourth edition (WAIS-IV). La Wechsler Adult Intelligence Scale (o WAIS) è il più noto test d'intelligenza utilizzato in età adulta e applicabile dal sedicesimo anno di età (16-90 anni). The Wechsler Intelligence Scale for Children (WISC), developed by David Wechsler, is an individually administered intelligence test for children between the ages of 6 and 16. Wechsler Intelligence Scale Test Variations. WPPSI – Wechsler Pre-School & Primary Scale of Intelligence – test covers children from 2 years and 6 months to 7 years and 7 months.
