The Prince (Italian: *Il Principe* [il ˈprintʃipe]) is a 16th-century political treatise by the Italian diplomat and political theorist Niccolò Machiavelli. From his correspondence, a version appears to have been distributed in 1513, using a Latin title, *De Principatibus* (Of Principalities). Oscar Wilde wrote the story "The happy Prince" and he often named the stories that he wrote like this one, as "fairy-stories". He originally wrote the song for the musical trio he created by the name of Apollonia 6 in 1984. Manic Monday never made it to the studio for Apollonia 6 as Prince didn't think the group was fully up to the task, and soon lost interest in the band as a project. The Prince is basically a guidebook for new leaders and rulers. Machiavelli stresses that those new in the government must make efforts to earn the support of the common people because in it lays the foundation to success.
